INDECENT EXPOSURE

Claremont, CA – On Sunday March 18 at about 8:40 p.m., a female was jogging in the 200 block of W. Foothill Blvd. (south side). The suspect was standing behind a short wall, gained the victim's attention and exposed himself to her. The suspect got in the suspect vehicle and fled south on Harvard Ave.

On Sunday March 25 at about 3 p.m., two females were followed by the suspect in the suspect vehicle in the area of Sixth St. and Mills Ave. The victims saw the suspect making a hand motion that appeared as if he was fondling himself. The suspect then fled south on Claremont Blvd.

On Tuesday March 27 at about 9:40 a.m., a witness saw the suspect expose himself to a passing jogger in the 200 block of W. Eleventh St. The suspect got into the suspect vehicle and fled west on Eleventh St.

SUSPECT: Male Hispanic or Middle Eastern, mid-20's, 6'0" – 6'3", 190 - 200 lbs., black hair, possible facial hair, glasses
