Claremont, CA – For the last few years, the City of Claremont has maintained an online archive of public information and City documents, which includes past City Council and Commission agenda packets, resolutions, minutes, and ordinances of the City, with most dating back as far as 1907. The City of Claremont takes pride in providing public information to the community through the City website. More and more public information has been made available through the City's website with increasing technological advances.

The City also maintains protected and confidential information. While the City has implemented security measures to protect confidential information, such as employee records, recent activities have demonstrated that there has been a breach of confidential documents.

As a result, we regret that, until further notice, access to the City's archive through the City website will be unavailable as we look further into this matter. We apologize for this inconvenience.
