Commercial Burglary Suspects Arrested

Claremont, CA – On October 29, 2018 at 12:01 AM, an observant citizen called to report a burglary-in-progress at Jamba Juice and Poke Dot located at 175 N. Indian Hill Bl. Suite B-101A and Suite B-101B. Officers arrived within seconds and observed the suspect vehicle leaving southbound on Indian Hill Bl. from the businesses. As officers attempted an enforcement stop on the suspect vehicle, the driver fled, and a vehicle pursuit ensued. The Officers pursued the suspects onto the westbound IS-10 freeway. Officers pursued the suspects for approximately 30 minutes. The pursuit terminated in Los Angeles where the three suspects ran from their vehicle. All three suspects were apprehended after a foot pursuit. CHP and Glendale PD assisted with the apprehension of the suspects at the termination point of the pursuit. Evidence was located inside the suspect vehicle from the burglaries. The three suspects were arrested and transported to the Claremont PD Jail for booking.

Arrested was Jailynn Cottrell, 18 years old, of Lancaster for felony evading, burglary, possession of burglary tools, resisting arrest and conspiracy. He is being held in lieu of \$75,000 bail at the Claremont PD Jail.

Arrested was Davine Bruce, 18 years old, of Palmdale for burglary, possession of burglary tools, resisting arrest and conspiracy. He is being held in lieu of \$20,000 bail at the Claremont PD Jail.

Arrested was a 15 year old juvenile, of Long Beach for burglary, possession of burglary tools, resisting arrest and conspiracy. The juvenile is currently being held at Los Padrinos Juvenile Hall.
