## CicLAvia Special Resident Access on 04/22/18

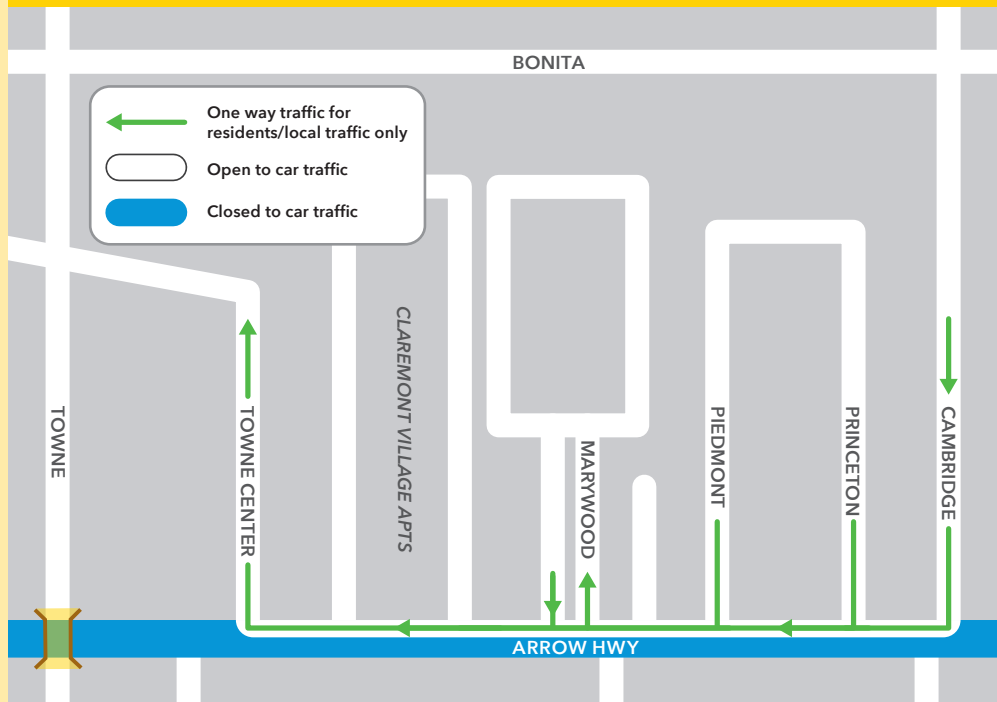
On Sunday, April 22, CicLAvia– Heart of the Foothills will remove cars from the streets and open them up for people to walk, skate, bike, play, and explore. There will be no parking or vehicle access on certain streets during CicLAvia (see map). The event runs from 9am to 4pm with street closures in effect from 7am to 6pm.

Certain streets in Claremont and adjacent cities will be closed from 7am to approximately 6pm. Special access will be given to residents who live on Princeton, Piedmont, Marywood, Towne Center, and in the Claremont Village Apartments north of Arrow Hwy (see map).

**Special Access on Sunday, April 22:** Residents who live in the affected areas shown on the map will be offered **one-way, westbound** access on Arrow Highway to exit their homes during our event times. To return home, residents must use southbound Cambridge to westbound Arrow Hwy (see map).
