

**NOTICE OF A PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING THE CITY OF CLAREMONT'S  
PROPOSED COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM BUDGET**

**PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that a public hearing will be held on **January 22, 2019 at 7 p.m.**, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, in the Claremont City Council Chamber, 225 W. Second Street, Claremont, before the Claremont City Council (City) to review the proposed budget for use of the City's Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds for Fiscal Year 2019-2020. Any person wishing to be heard on this matter is invited to attend this public hearing and speak.

The 2019-2020 budget is proposed as follows:

Project/Program	Budget
Housing Rehabilitation Program	\$ 60,000
Senior Case Management Program	\$ 21,737
Job Creation & Business Incentive Grant Program	\$ 85,948
Total	\$167,685

This matter is covered by the general rule that the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) applies only to projects that have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment in accordance with Section 15061 (b)(3) of the Guidelines. The approval of the annual CDBG budget will not in itself have a significant effect on the environment because the action will not result in or lead to a significant physical change in Claremont. Any projects receiving assistance through the CDBG programs will be evaluated independently to determine whether they are subject to environmental review.
