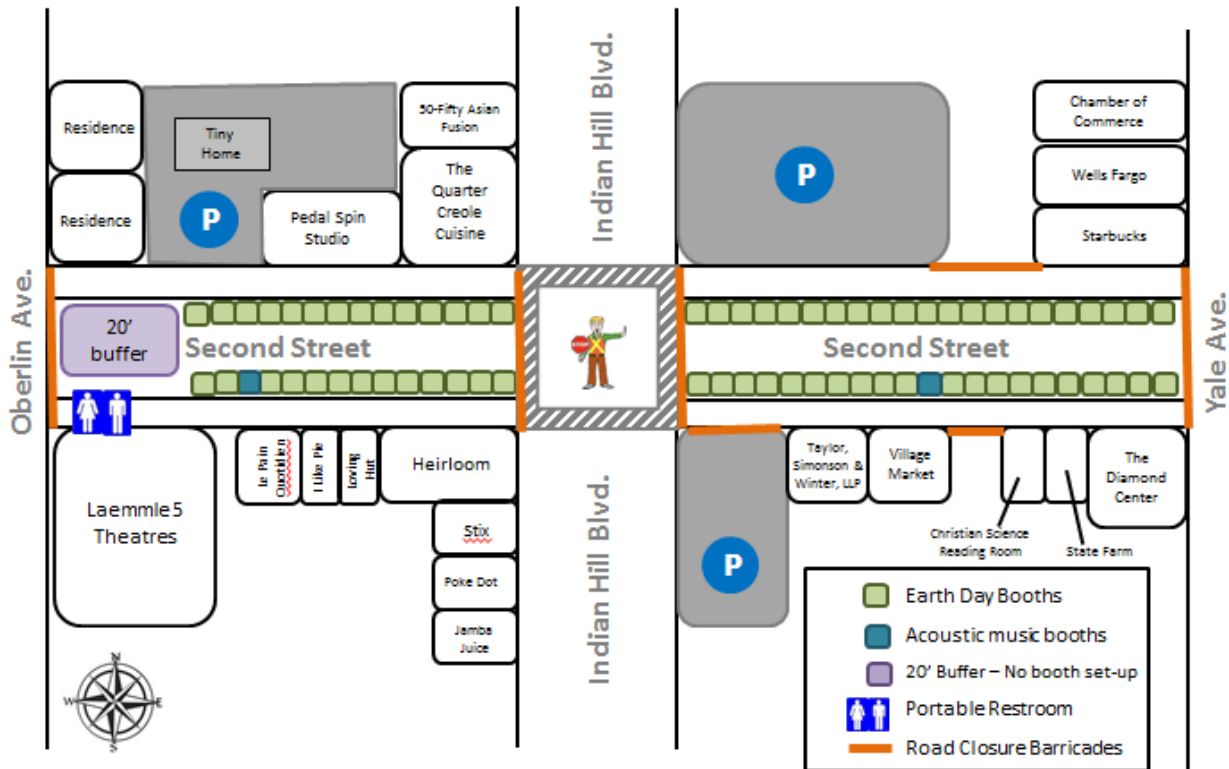




NOTICE OF SPECIAL EVENT PERMIT EARTH DAY CELEBRATION APRIL 14, 2019

Claremont Earth Day Celebration & Street Fair (File # 19-SEP02)
Time & Date: Sunday, April 14, 2019, from 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

Sustainable Claremont, in association with the City of Claremont, will be hosting the annual Claremont Earth Day Celebration and Street Fair on Sunday, April 14, 2019. The event will be held between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. with street closures planned to commence as early as 5:00 a.m. and end as late as 3:00 p.m. The event will be located along Second Street within the Claremont Village from Oberlin Avenue to Yale Avenue with north/south streets such as Oberlin Avenue, Indian Hill Boulevard, and Yale Avenue to remain open for vehicular access as indicated in the map below. The event will include food trucks, live entertainment, activities, and approximately 80 exhibitor and vendor booths.



The approval of this event is not subject to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15304(e) of the CEQA Guidelines in that it involves minor temporary use of land having negligible or no permanent effects on the environment as the proposed special event is of short duration and will not create long-term impacts to the City of Claremont. Therefore, no further environmental review is necessary.
