- ◆ Participants requiring a wheelchair, caregiver, or who have other mobility issues must notify the Joslyn Center at time of registration. Caregivers must also register for the activity.
- ◆ Trips depart from the Hughes Community Center (1700 Danbury Road) unless otherwise indicated. Parking is available in the south parking lot. It is requested that participants do not park in front of the Hughes entrance. Transportation to and from departure location must be arranged by the participant.
- ◆ Participants should arrive at least 15 minutes prior to departure.
- ◆ Bus seating may be selected on a first-come, first-served basis. Participants should use the same seat throughout the day.
- ◆ All buses are air conditioned and have restrooms.
- ◆ Refunds must be requested no later than one week prior to the trip unless otherwise indicated on the receipt. A \$5 handling fee will be applied to all refund requests.
- ◆ Trip details are subject to change based on traffic, weather, construction, and other conditions beyond control.
- ◆ Excursions may be cancelled by the Claremont Senior Program if minimum registration is not met. A full refund will be provided.
