**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the City of Claremont will hold a **PUBLIC HEARING** to consider adoption of an ordinance amending Title 15 of the Claremont Municipal Code related to Claremont's Building Codes. The proposed ordinance will adopt the 2019 California Building Codes with certain amendments necessary to meet local conditions. The proposed ordinance will continue Claremont's local amendments. All interested persons are invited to appear and to be heard at the public hearing.

The **PUBLIC HEARING** will be held on **Tuesday, November 26, 2019**, beginning at 7 p.m., in the Council Chamber, located at 225 West Second Street, Claremont. The City Council is the decision-making body for ordinances.
