### **Volunteers Needed for Claremont Homeless Count 2020**

Claremont, CA – On Tuesday, January 21, 2020, the City of Claremont will participate in the 2020 Greater Los Angeles Homeless Count in partnership with the Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority (LAHSA). The City is currently recruiting volunteers to assist with this important community effort. Please include your name and phone number, and if you are interested in being a driver. Volunteers will meet at the Joslyn Center on 660 N. Mountain Avenue at 8:00 p.m. on the evening of the count to receive training, maps, materials, and assignments. Teams of two to four volunteers will then be deployed to count specific blocks within Claremont. All Claremont routes will be counted from a private vehicle; therefore, no walking is required. It is estimated that each team will spend 2-3 hours in the field. This is an excellent opportunity for individuals to make an impact by contributing to the City's Collaborative Community Response to Claremont Homelessness. The data gathered during this count will be used to determine how vital resources and services will be provided to the homeless individuals and families that reside in our community and throughout the Los Angeles area.
